This letter is one of the most upsetting letters I have ever written.

As you are aware the Minister has Proclaimed May 1, 2017 as the date the \$1 Industry Levy begins. The Meters will be upgraded by Cabcharge & MTData automatically. The \$1 Levy will be displayed as an extra at the beginning of the fare and treated separately from the fare.

The driver needs to ensure that the levy money is not misplaced and has to pass it on to the Government via the Relevant Provider which will either be Adelaide Independent Taxis or the Taxi Operator.

Late last night we received Letters / Information from the Minister's Department on the detail of the Levy and it varies from our original understanding.

Either AIT and the Taxi Operator will need to remit the Levy to the Government and the driver needs to remit the levy to them. This is a game changer.

AIT is preparing a Levy Payment System that may address the requirements. A Website is being prepared where the Driver will be able to transfer the Levy money to.

Please understand that this may not be the final solution as there may be changes in light of the recent information received.
