POLICING OF ROAD USERS IN THE CITY OF ADELAIDE

Further to the successful operation by SA Police at the Hindley Street/Morphett Street intersections advised to the industry in October, we have now been advised that there will be ongoing traffic watch on all motorists (including taxi and private plated vehicles) and pedestrian behaviour.

Police will be targeting offences such as blocking lanes and intersections, stopping in no standing zones and general behaviour around the former Taxi Concierge monitored areas. These targeted operations will be conducted during the summer months and into autumn.

Traffic congestion is most evident in the early hours of Saturday and Sunday mornings and the planned operation, while being conducted over all hours, will again have a strong focus on the heavy vehicle and pedestrian traffic during those hours.

SA Police have asked that we let you know that whilst this operation will be on all road users, taxis form a large percentage of the vehicle traffic in the early hours of the mornings. You are asked to obey all traffic rules, being particularly mindful not to block the flow of traffic.

The Concierges are no longer managing the ranks; however, the Taxi Council asks that you continue to use these ranks which are **exclusively** for the use of licensed taxis, rather than pick up off the street and risk blocking traffic.

Please report all private vehicles on taxi ranks to the City of Adelaide on 8203 7203.
